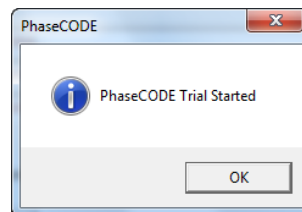


PhaseCODE Trial Period

After installing the PhaseCODE software, double click the PhaseCODE icon on the desktop to run the program. The computer should be connected to the Internet. When the *PhaseCODE Registration* dialog box comes up, fill in the registration data and click the **Start Trial** button.

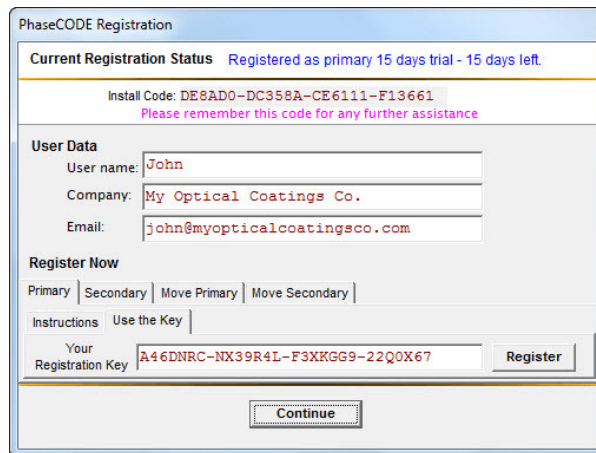

PhaseCODE Registration

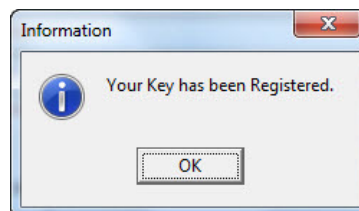
The PhaseCODE software can be licensed in different ways. The most common way is to purchase a permanent license which comes with free software upgrades for a period of one year from the date of purchase. Besides this option, the PhaseCODE can be leased for any number of days that the license key is issued for. When the software is leased, each time the program is started, the computer has to be connected to the Internet in order to verify the remaining lease time.

When the license key is issued and emailed to the user, the PhaseCODE can be registered as described below (the example shows a permanent license):

- 1) The computer should be connected to the Internet.
- 2) From the PhaseCODE menu bar, click *Help* → *Registration*.
- 3) In the *PhaseCODE Registration* dialog box click the **Primary** tab, then click the **Use the Key** tab. In *Your Registration Key* field enter the license key. Click the **Register** button.



When the message *Your Key has been Registered* comes up, click **OK** button.

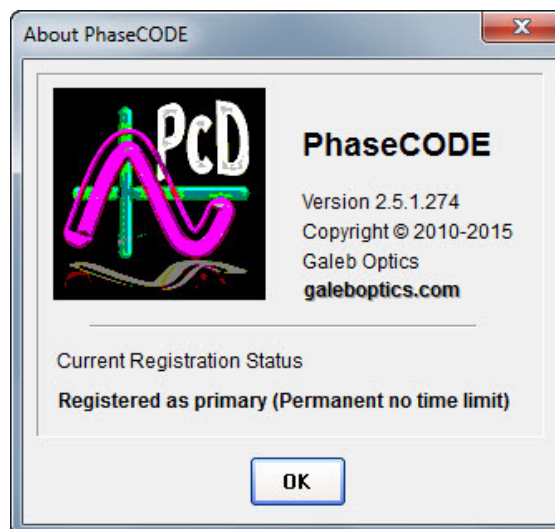

The new registration status can be also verified from the PhaseCODE menu bar by selecting *Help* → *About ...*



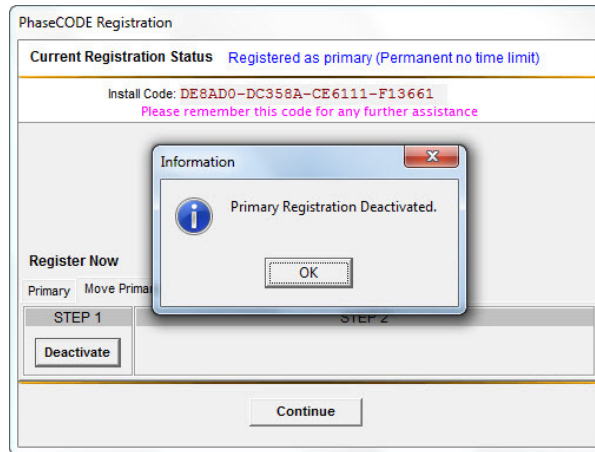
How to move the primary license from one computer to another

Suppose that a user of the PC1 computer wants to replace the computer and transfer the primary license from PC1 to PC2 computer. This can be accomplished in two steps, assuming that both computers are connected to the Internet, and that PC2 has the same version of the PhaseCODE installed as PC1. Follow the steps below:

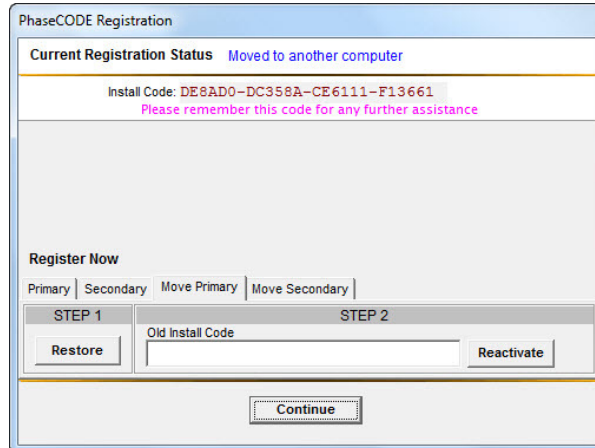
Step 1

- 1) PC1 should be connected to the Internet.
- 2) From the PhaseCODE menu bar, click *Help* → *Registration*.

- 3) To deactivate the license on the PC1, in the *PhaseCODE Registration* dialog box click the **Move Primary** tab, and then click the **Deactivate** button. The message *Primary Registration Deactivated* will appear. After closing the message box, the **Deactivate** button will change the caption to **Restore**. In case the **Deactivate** button was pressed by mistake, click the **Restore** button to go back to the original status of registration.



- 4) After the primary license has been disabled on PC1, click the **Continue** button to initiate the transfer of the license to PC2.

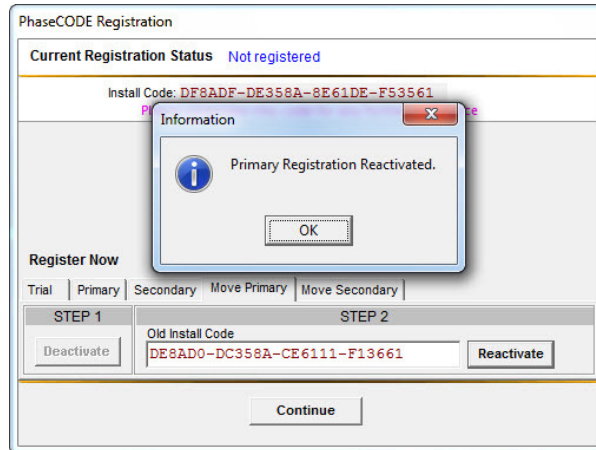


NOTE ... The *Current Registration Status* has changed from *Registered as primary (Permanent no time limit)* to *Moved to another computer*. After clicking the **Continue** button, the PhaseCODE application will close since the license key has been deactivated.

Step 2

- 1) PC2 should be connected to the Internet.

- 2) Run the PhaseCODE application.
- 3) To reactivate the license on the PC2, in the *PhaseCODE Registration* dialog box click the **Move Primary** tab, and in the *Old Install Code* field enter the Install Code from PC1. Click the **Reactivate** button.



- 4) The *Current Registration Status* on the PC2 has changed from *Not Registered* to *Registered as primary (Permanent no time limit)*.
